- Reviewing technical manuals, websites, and data bases to assist with the diagnosis and repair of equipment.
- Operating a service vehicle for on-site customer repairs. Must possess a valid driver license and a clean driving record.
- Working as part of a team with other technicians, service manager, service coordinator, parts coordinator(s), and sales personnel.
- Combination of in-shop work and work at customer locations, including some out of town work from time to time.
- Minimum 40 hour work week with occasional overtime, plus rotating after-hours on-call and possible weekends as the business requires. Occasional overnight travel may occur depending on customer location and requirements.
- Some administrative tasks including completion of work orders, reports, safety forms, etc
